Site navigation is easy. Each option on the top left has a dropdown menu, clicking the FamilySearch icon on any page brings you back to this page.



Clicking on Family Tree shows these options

Be sure to read "Overview" (it explains how the tree is one large collaborative tree with 1.2 billon people).



Clicking on Tree will show your tree

There are several options: Landscape, Fan, Portrait, and Descendancy.

This is the Landscape view.



This is the Fan Chart view

There are several display options shown on the left side. Hover you mouse over any person and an option is shown to move them to the center of the chart.



Because FamilySearch Tree is one large collaborative tree, some of your own tree is probably already there. You just need to connect to it.

Most of our Kalloch Family Tree is already entered.

If you have any difficulty connecting to your Kalloch family line, please let me (Ken Kalloch) know.

Connecting to or adding people to the tree

Here my father's parents are not connected. Click on "Add Father" or "Add Mother" to see if they are already in the tree or add them to the tree.



After clicking "Add Father" this box is shown

I know my grandfather is Sumner Boyd Kalloch, so I fill in what I know and click Next.

Family Search ID Numbers

Everyone in the tree is given a unique ID number which is 4 digits, followed by a hyphen, and 3 digits. You can add, find, or merge people in the tree by using their ID numbers.



Editing Relationship Information is Easy

In Person View, each person or couple has a small icon to the right of their name, clicking on it will show a pop-up menu where you can edit relationship information.
