**HOW TO JOIN THE MEETING:** "Zoom" is a computer program that allows people to talk and see each other over the internet. You can install and use it for free. To use Zoom, you will need a computer or tablet with a microphone, and preferably, a camera. Zoom is fairly easy to use, but if you struggle with computers, you might ask a more tech-savvy relative to help you out. If you have never used it before, it will take a few extra minutes to get set up.

Whether you have used Zoom before or not, start by going to the following web address: <a href="https://us02web.zoom.us/j/85006135421?pwd=REhraktQTTM4UIFEMW54Tnd4Z0Zodz09">https://us02web.zoom.us/j/85006135421?pwd=REhraktQTTM4UIFEMW54Tnd4Z0Zodz09</a> (This is the link to our meeting.) If this is your first time using Zoom: you will see the following message: "If nothing prompts from browser, download & run Zoom." Within a few seconds, an orange box with an arrow should appear at the bottom of the screen. If that doesn't happen after 20 seconds or so, click on "download & run Zoom." to make the box appear. Then, click on the icon reading "Zoom.pkg" just below the orange box. Follow your computer's instructions to download and install the program. (A few helpful hints: Your computer may make you confirm that you want to install the program; that is fine. If you have the option to change any of the default settings, just leave them be, unless you are experienced with program installation.)

If a button appears with the message "Join a Meeting", click on it. You may be prompted to enter a Meeting ID and/or a password; our Meeting ID is 850 0613 5421 and our password is 445198. You can choose to join with or without video; this depends on whether or not you would like us all to see your lovely face...no pressure! If a button reading "Join With Computer Audio" appears, click it. At this point, you should be able to see and hear the other meeting attendees.

You may join the meeting late or leave early, but we may not be able to help you log in once the meeting has started. **If you would like to practice using Zoom:** there will be 2 "practice sessions" before the day of the reunion: Tuesday, August 11 at 7:00 PM and Wednesday, August 12 at 7:00 PM. 
